Frequently Asked Questions

1) Airline Tickets

There are no physical tickets. You will present your ID at the counter to receive your boarding pass.

2) SDSU Clinic

3) Parking

Given our departure and return times, we have been given permission to leave our vehicles at WTHS. Park at your own risk and group the cars together in the faculty parking lot.

4) Spending Money
