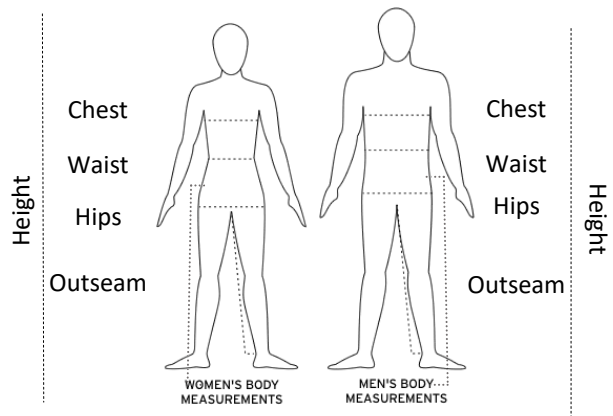

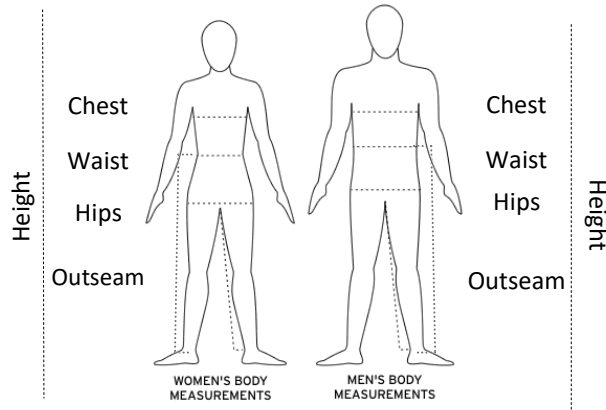

* How to Measure

Chest: Measure at the fullest part of the chest, keeping measuring tape comfortable.

Boys: Suit jacket size is a good indicator.

** Please indicate if you student is or will be drum line and if the harness is over or under the jacket.

Waist: Measure at the top of the hip bone to find the **natural** waistline, keeping measuring tape comfortable. (Gently poke along the side to find the top of the hip bone.)

Hips: Measure at the fullest part of the hip.

Outseam: Measure from the top of the hip bone (see "Waist" above) to the bottom of the ball of the ankle.
